VIKING LAKE PARK RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- The state liquor authority rules prohibit anyone from bringing their own alcoholic beverages into the building, the grounds surrounding it, and the picnic area. This rule is strictly enforced. Violators may be asked to leave immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS. Only those 21 and older may sit at the bar. Beer is 6 packs purchased at the bar can't be consumed in the bar area. After 9pm, anyone younger than 21 must leave the bar area.
- Reminder, this is a family club! Appropriate language! No lodge business shall be discussed at the bar. Shirts AND shoes must be worn in the building.
- Membership cards MUST be shown as you arrive at the Lake Park. Membership cards are non-transferable.
- All guests including guest spouses and adult children must be signed in by a member. Your guests must leave the park when you do.
- If you need assistance carrying your order to your table, let them know when you place your order.
- Activities are not permitted at the park after closing hour of the bar.
- Our picnic groves and grounds are for the enjoyment of all, for safety purposes:
NO DOGS, NO BICYCLES, skateboards, or ball playing are permitted near the building or grove at any time.
NO hunting on Viking property at any time, this includes days the club is closed.
- All tables, chairs, glasses, and bottles taken from the main building must be returned before you leave the park. Please remove all litter from your tables and place in the garbage cans. We don't have critters and don't want them in the picnic area.
- To park in handicapped spots you must have a handicapped sticker or license plate.
- Golf carts must be parked in the designated area only.
- Please change wet swimwear in the outside bathrooms.
- Parents are responsible for their children's behavior. Please supervise young children.
- Employees ONLY allowed in the kitchen.
